DON'T WALK AWAY FROM HOPE

As we listen to our leaders, we hear a single word, over and over again. You turn on the news broadcast, whether it is radio or television, and you don't listen long until you hear this word. When you talk to family, friends, church members, business associates, a stranger at the mall or whomever, you will invariably hear this word.
