Administrative Bishop Daniel Hampton has asked Pastor Mick Frye of Fountain of Life Worship Center to share in this month's newsletter about the revival that has been going on at their church with Revivalist Nik Walker.

For the past year and a half, cancellations, disappointments, and uncertainties have become a sad reality for everyone. For many churches, cancelled services, groups, and revivals have become the norm, with some churches even closing down. When Pastor Mick Frye scheduled revivalist Nik Walker to come to the Fountain of Life Worship Center to hold a Sunday through Wednesday revival in early October, he did it in faith. He, and everyone else who attended, was blown away by what happened.

Nik Walker, 25, along with his prayer team which consists of a group of people ranging in ages from 10 years old and up, are on fire for God and have a heart to see revival in West Virginia and the rest of the world. They have traveled together and seen God do amazing things but have stated that this is unlike anything they've ever been a part of, which is also true for those in attendance of the revival.

This revival has been described as real and authentic. With several churches from the community, as well as people from outside of the community traveling to take part and come together in unity to see true revival. Not only are there different churches, but there are also several different denominations taking part. Pastor Frye stated, "I don't want this to be seen as a Fountain of Life Worship Center revival, I want this to be seen as a community revival. A God thing."

A God thing it is. With many healings taking place, including a woman who was hearing impaired since birth gaining full hearing, drawn hands straightened before the eyes of everyone in attendance, a confirmed meniscus tear instantly healed, a woman with vision issues who couldn't read the screen at church but now can, a lady came in on a walker and walked the walker out, and several back issues including a girl with scoliosis so bad that she couldn't sit criss cross, or touch her toes was healed. Also, many witnessed the scars of a young girl who had been cutting her arm for a few months prior due to depression fade away. Many physical healings were seen, but also deliverance from past hurts, bitterness and unforgiveness, and oppressive spirits were experienced.

One of the most exciting things of the revival have been the many salvations. Including one young man who came to a service searching for "what he believed in" after being invited. As he felt the tug to give his heart to the Lord but still unsure, God highlighted the young man to Revivalist Nik Walker and he

stopped in the middle of his message to look at him. He told him that he wasn't sure why he was staring at him or talking to him directly. However, he felt that God wanted him to ask him if he was ready, and when he did, the young man said yes, gave his heart to Jesus and went directly to be baptized. Shortly after, the young man's girlfriend gave her heart to Jesus and as the revival continued into the next week, his brother and his brother's girlfriend, as well as his sister and her boyfriend gave their hearts to Jesus, all being baptized right then and there.

A sovereign move of God has been experienced but didn't come without a price. It is no surprise that the revival happened just a couple weeks after the church hosted a 4-week ladies prayer conference. Each night of the revival, the church opens at 5:00 with the prayer team praying and preparing for the service that evening and not leaving most nights until close to or after midnight. Every seat in the church is prayed over before each service. Each service was opened by one of the members of prayer team who prayed down heaven and set the tone for the service.

However, it is obvious that this move is from God alone and not brought on by any one person. It is just a group of people hungry for revival and ready to step into what God wants to do.

The revival, which is now being described as an awakening, is currently entering into the fourth week with nearly 90 decisions for Christ and close to 200 baptisms. Revivalist Nik Walker stated that it is his desire, when he holds revivals, that people are not only revived, but that the culture of the places he goes to is changed. This is the prayer of those at the Fountain of Life Worship Center as well.
