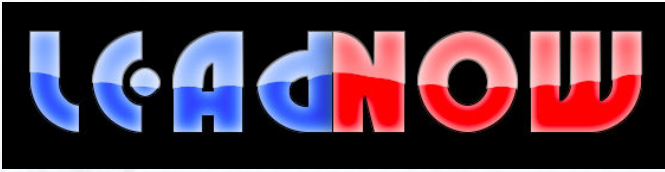
2018 MINISTER & SPOUSE CHRISTMAS BANQUET
