

### LET THE WIND BLOW

We are now in the month of March and usually it comes with the wind, which reminds us that seasonal change is coming. We all have heard or used the phrase in referring to March; "If it comes in like a lion, it will go out like a lamb, or if it comes in like a lamb it will go out like a lion." Lord may the mighty rushing wind that blew on the day of Pentecost blow again so forcefully that people of our communities will run to our houses of worship to experience this outpouring. Let it blow away everything in its path that is not fulfilling His perfect will.

The Church of God was birthed out of a hunger for the presence of God in a way they had never seen before and when the Holy Ghost came upon those believers at the Shearer School House change came. Our theme this year is "Believing For Great Things," and I am believing for the mighty wind of Pentecost to blow across West Virginia like none of us have ever witnessed.

I am alarmed today as to how quiet and sedated so many of our churches are. It is time for the church to arise and proclaim loudly in the face of all the noise of violence that Jesus Christ is the answer.
