The words we speak are so important that I felt compelled to write this article to caution us to consider very carefully what we allow to come from our mouth. Our language and how we speak can produce positive or negative reactions to those who hear our words. Careful consideration of the talk we give must, especially in today's environment, be foremost on our mind. James 3:8 "But the tongue can no man tame; it is an unruly evil, full of deadly poison." What are we saying to this generation that will uplift and produce goodness and righteousness?

Not only is the tongue an instrument of destruction but it can also be an instrument of value, health life and prosperity. Read carefully the following scriptures and ask yourself, "Am I using my tongue in this way?"

Proverbs 10:20 "The tongue of the just is as choice silver"

Proverbs 12:18 "The tongue of the wise is health"

Proverbs 15:4 "A wholesome tongue is a tree of life"

Proverbs 18:21 "Death and life are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof." In light of the scriptures, which I have shared above, these are what I would consider to be the most powerful words that we can say. Read carefully, and no doubt you may even think of other words which could be added to this list.

- 1. **I BELIEVE:** Mark 9:23 "Jesus said unto him, if thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth." What do you believe? Who are you believing in that will assure you of an eternity in heaven? We must believe that Jesus Christ is the only way to salvation and the only one who can save us from our sin. I believe that if we the church will get ourselves in the right spiritual condition we can have another great awakening in our nation. I believe the Holy Spirit is ready to be poured out like a mighty flood across our land.
- 2. **I CARE:** Luke 10:33-35 "But a certain Samaritan, as he journeyed, came where he was: and when he saw him, he had compassion on him, (34). And went to him and bound up his wounds, pouring in oil and wine, and set him on his own beast, and brought him to an inn, and took care of him. (35). And on the morrow when he departed, he took out two pence, and gave them to the host, and said unto him, Take care of him; and whatsoever thou spendest more, when I come again I will repay thee." Do we really care about the lost, the hurting, the oppressed and the sinner enough to share the hope of redemption? If we don't share Jesus, who is going to care enough to tell this generation of the hope that is in Him.

- 3. **I FORGIVE:** Matthew 6:12 (NLT) "And forgive us our sins, as we have forgiven those who sin against us." Matthew 6:15 "But if you refuse to forgive others, your Father will not forgive your sins." Every one of us has experienced the need for forgiveness. You may even remember while reading this article of some deep hurt that happened in your past that you thought you would never be able to get over. You were betrayed or mistreated and the hurt was deep, but I want you to remember the real joy when you made the choice to forgive and the peace which filled your heart. Nothing is greater than to know we are forgiven and within us through Jesus is the power to forgive those who have done us wrong.
- 4. **I NEED:** Revelation 3:17 & 18 "Because thou sayest, I am rich, and increased with goods, and have need of nothing; and knowest not that thou art wretched and miserable, and poor, and blind, and naked: (18). I counsel thee to buy of me gold tried in the fire, that thou mayest be rich; and white raiment, that thou mayest be clothed, and that the shame of thy nakedness do not appear; and anoint thine eyes with eye salve, that thou mayest see." I need to see clearly through spiritual eyes what is going on today and help shine the light of the gospel in this darkness. Let your light shine so men and women will approach you and ask "What is this hope you have?"
- 5. **I SUBMIT:** I Peter 4:7 "Submit yourselves therefore to God, resist the devil, and he will flee from you." Romans 8:29 (NLT) "For God knew his people in advance, and he chose them to become like his Son, so that his Son would be the firstborn among many brothers and sisters." Ephesians 5:21 "Submitting yourselves one to another in the fear of God." If there has ever been a time we need to exemplify submission to God, it is now. With the spirit of rebellion we are seeing on a daily basis the church needs to be the light shining brightly with the fruit of the Spirit; love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness, and temperance. Whenever I pass an orchard and I see the ripe fruit on the branches I want to stop and pick whatever fruit there is and taste how delicious it is. May we as the people of God let the fruit of the Spirit be so inviting to those around us that they will want to taste and see that the Lord, He is good.




