New River Ranch

If you've ever been around a construction site, you have witnessed a giant mess being made. Things are dug up and out. There's a pile of this over here and that over there. It looks like chaos. Yet, somehow, we can see all of it and not be too concerned about the mess. We know that someone has a building plan and, eventually, all of that mess will be cleaned up and a structure will emerge. We seem to recognize the mess as part of the process. All of that mess is really just evidence that construction is unfinished.

I wonder if we could view life that way – for ourselves as well as others. What may look like a mess in life is just an indication that it's unfinished! In Jeremiah 29:11, the Lord said, "For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the Lord, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope" (NKJV).

For me, one of the most interesting parts of this verse is the Lord had just told the people of Israel they would be in Babylon for 70 years. The Lord affirmed that conditions were not ideal. He affirmed these folks were not where they wanted to be. Yet, in the midst of being in a position they didn't want, in a place they didn't choose, God had a plan for them. It was a mess. But it was unfinished. The Lord still had a plan for them.

This is the case for so many of the children the Lord allows us to serve. For them, life looks messy. Life feels messy. One of the things we hope to foster in them is hope that comes from knowing the God who has a plan and purpose for them. We want them to understand the mess is real, but it is unfinished. They are not where they want to be, but the builder is still working.

At New River Ranch, our mission is to help individuals grow into the people God designed them to be. We achieve this by creating a safe and structured environment where children can experience God's love, hear the Gospel, and learn to follow His plan for their lives. While the journey may be challenging—sometimes requiring hard work, laying foundations, or making necessary changes—we hold firm to God's promise of peace and a future filled with hope. Just as He has a plan to finish His work in their lives, He has one for yours as well. Even if it looks like a mess, the Lord just sees it as unfinished. Trust His plan!
